Our KS1/2 programme at Impact Alternative Learning is designed to re-engage young learners through a balance of academic foundations, creativity, and physical activity.

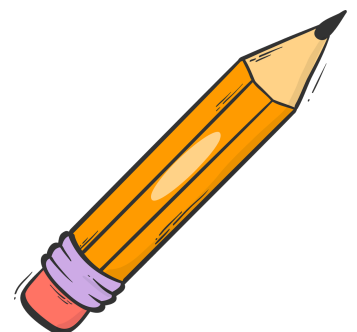
We recognise that many pupils at this stage benefit from a hands-on, nurturing environment, where learning is active, structured, and meaningful.

Creative & Practical Learning

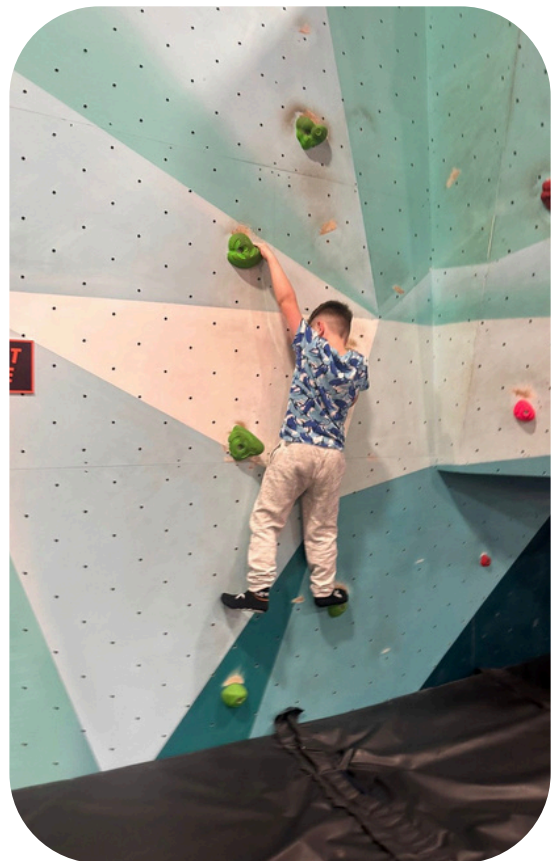
- Art, design, and creative expression
